FUTURE VISITS TO HOSPITALS

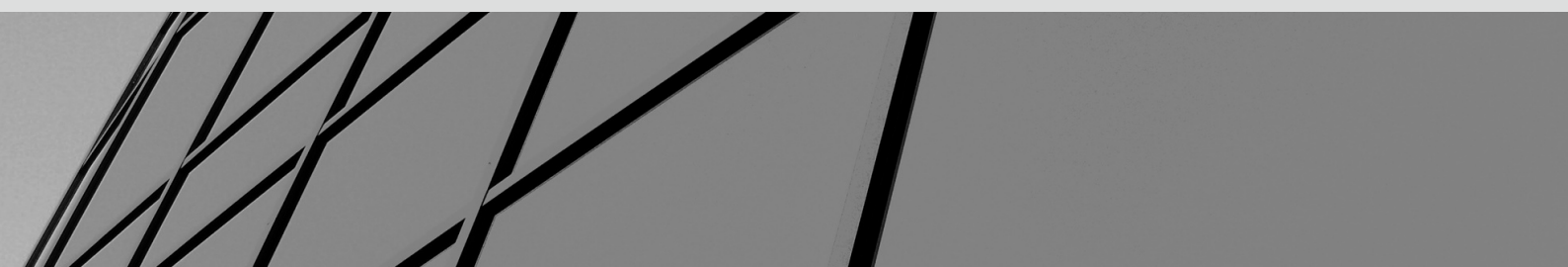

Conclusion

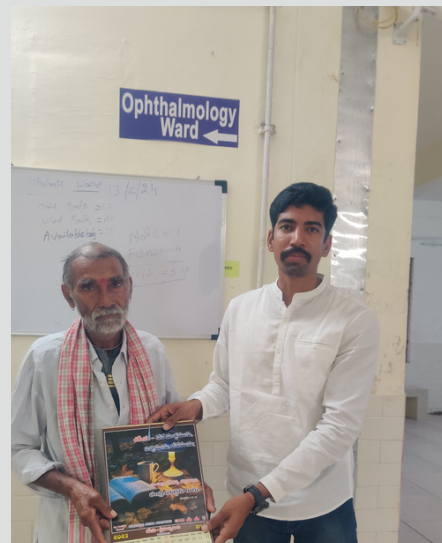
