When we stepped in, Nischala was provided with trauma counseling, legal aid, and a safe place to heal. Though the scars remain, she is slowly rebuilding her life. She now seeks justice and long-term emotional support as she navigates the darkness left behind by the cruelty she endured.



A WIDOW'S CRY: MADHURI AND HER BABY'S STRUGGLE FOR SURVIVAL

Madhuri lost her husband in a tragic accident, leaving her alone with their 2-year-old daughter Sneha. With no income, no support, and no shelter, she wandered the streets, desperately seeking food for her starving child. Her grief was unbearable, and her baby's cries only deepened her despair.
