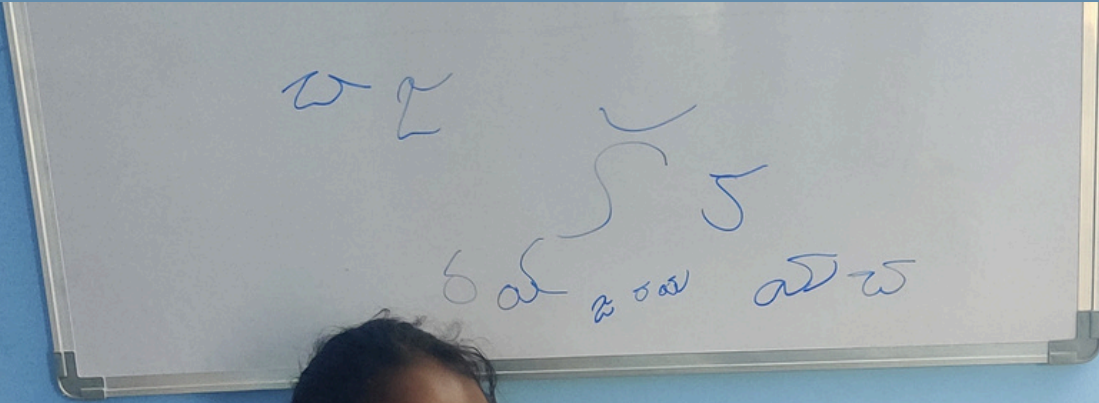

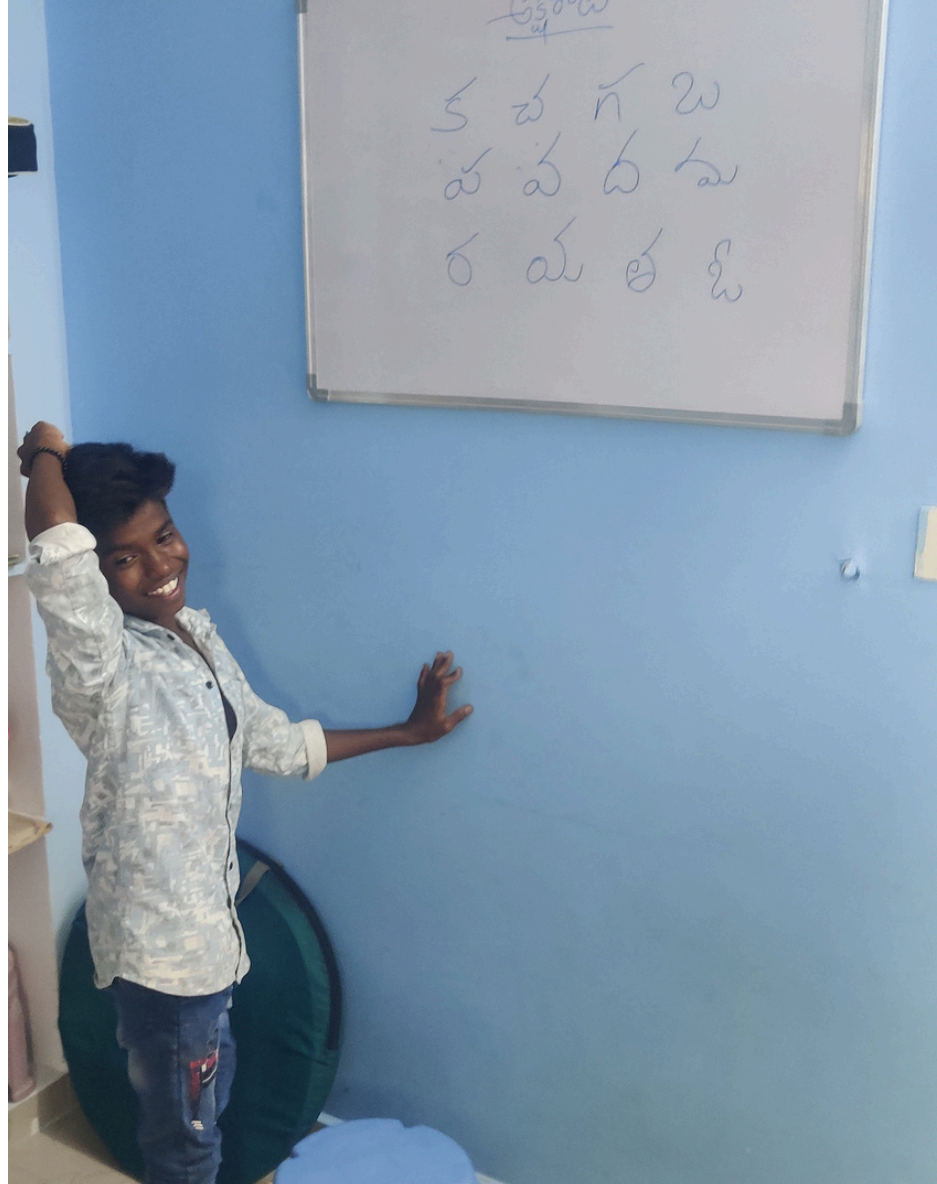

WHY TELUGU MATTERS

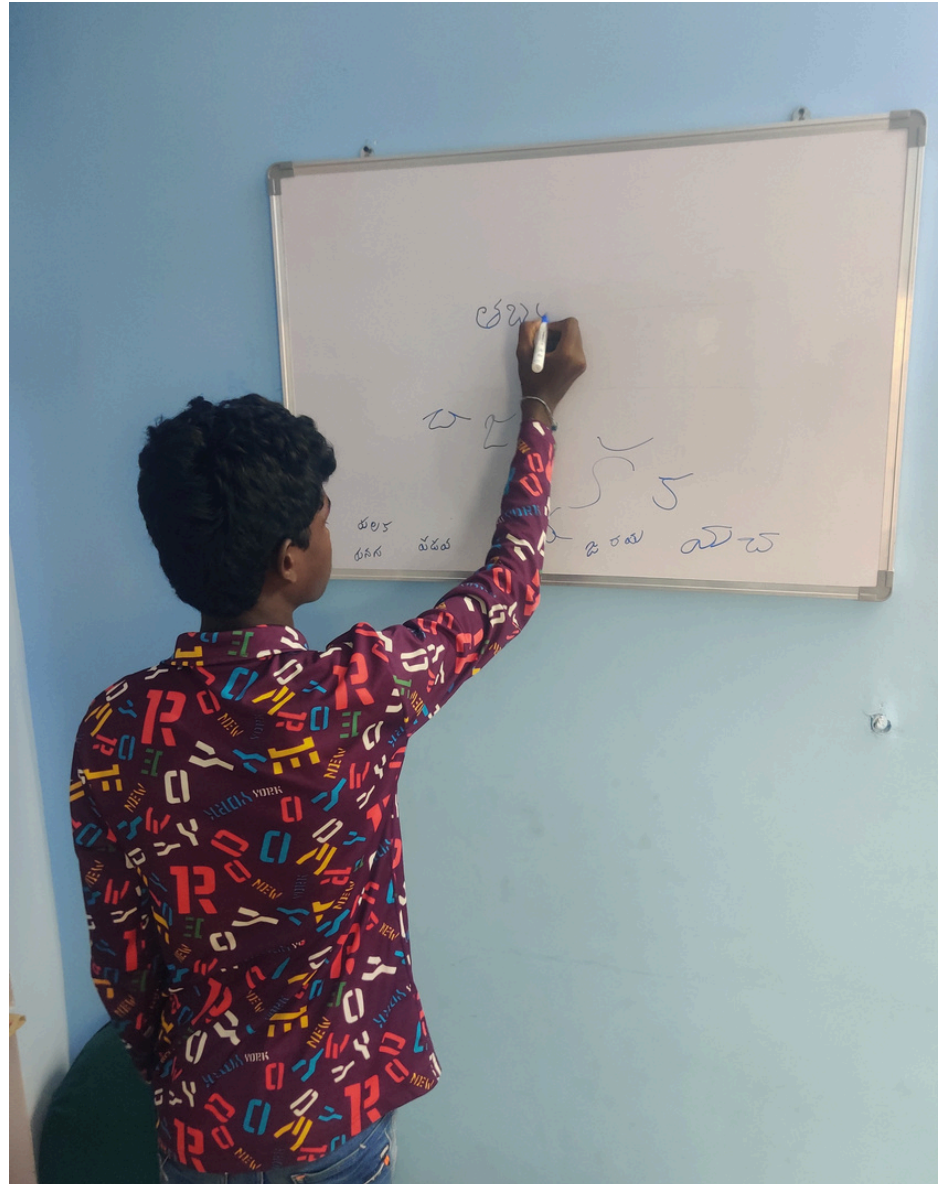

LITTLE MOMENTS, BIG SMILES

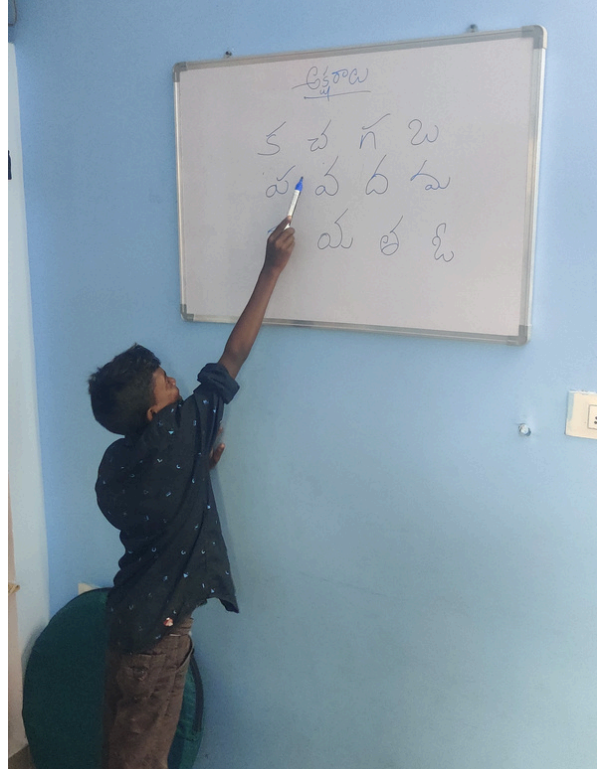

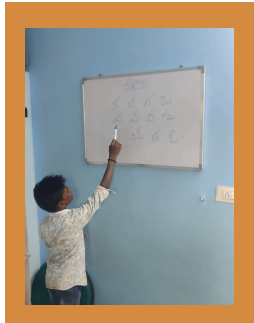
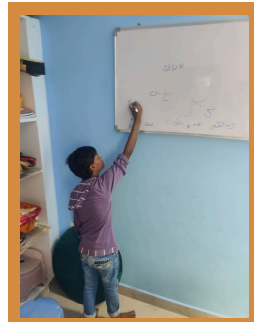
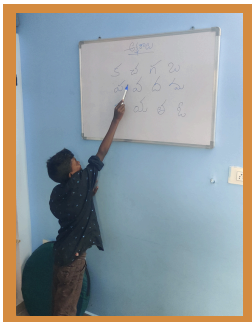
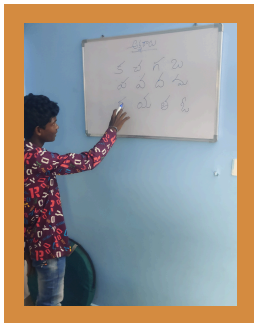
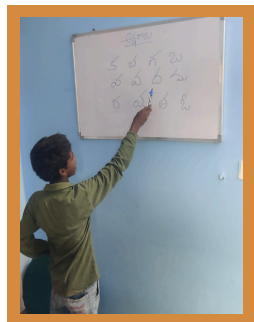
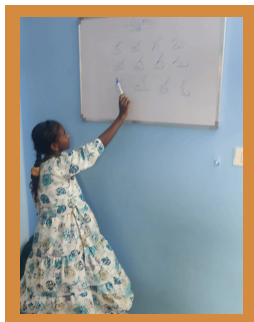
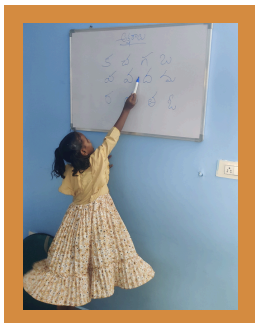
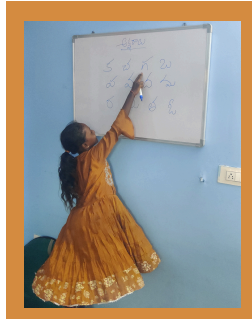
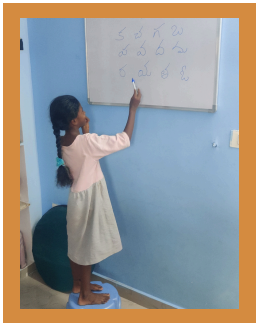
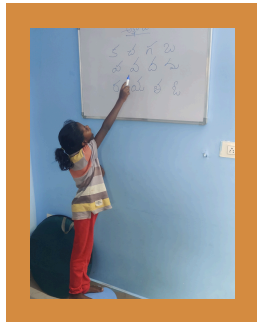
GRATITUDE AND DONOR APPRECIATION
